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Manuscripts submitted for publication should be typed and follow the conventions of Australian style as set out in the *Style Manual for Authors, Editors and Printers*, published by the Australian Government Publishing Service (fifth edition). All articles are refereed and should not normally exceed 6000 words in length. Notes and references should be grouped at the end of the article. We prefer to receive submissions as e-mail attachments either in rtf or as word documents. If submitting on disk please use Word for Windows IBM format.

Articles should deal with the economic, political, social, legal or philosophical significance of sporting activity. While most articles in the past have been on Australian sport and have had an historical focus, articles on other societies and on contemporary sport may be submitted for consideration.

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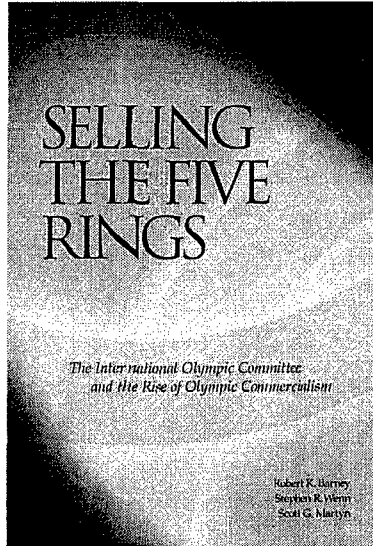
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
