

SUBMISSION OF MANUSCRIPTS

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Manuscripts submitted for publication should be typed and follow the general conventions of Australian style as set out in the *Style Manual for Authors, Editors and Printers*, published by the Australian Government Publishing Service (sixth edition). All articles are refereed and should not normally exceed 6000 words in length, including notes. Notes should always be grouped at the end of the article. It is highly recommended that authors consult the 'Style Guide for ASSH Publications' prior to the submission of their manuscript. The style guide is available on request from the Editor or from the website of the Society. Submission of articles by email is preferred. The manuscript should be attached either in Word or Rich Text format. Submissions by disk should be in Word for Windows (IBM format). Alternative formats must be negotiated with the Editor prior to submission.

Articles should deal with the economic, political, social, legal or philosophical significance of sporting activity. While most articles in the past have been on Australian sport and have had a strong historical focus, articles on other societies and on contemporary sport may be submitted for consideration.
