

## **assh** STUDENT ESSAY AND DISSERTATION PRIZES

ASSH offers two prizes annually for quality work by tertiary or secondary students in the general field of sports culture. Appropriate areas of focus are: sport and economics, sport in history, law, literature, philosophy, politics, social psychology and sociology. Sports culture and tradition should be seen as being broad not confined.

**The ASSH Dissertation Prize** will be awarded to an Honours Thesis written in 2003. One (returnable) copy should be submitted. The prize is \$200 and a one year subscription to ASSH. Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the judging panel. The winning dissertation may be published in an ASSH Study in Sports History.

**The ASSH Essay Prize** will be awarded to an essay written in 2003. Two copies should be submitted. The prize is \$200 and a one year subscription to ASSH. Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the judging panel. The winning essay may be published in the *ASSH Bulletin*.

All entries should be submitted in an unbound form for ease of duplication and dispersal to reading panels. Submissions should be sent to:
